6. Respect the reputation, profile and status of Business Mudgee, and represent the Chamber accordingly.
7. Whenever reasonably possible, participate in the functions and activities of the Chamber, and promote the enhancement of business growth within the Mid-Western region.
8. Refrain from publicly disparaging the business practices of fellow members and refrain from condoning or engaging in misrepresentation or unethical practices.
9. Refrain from engaging in any practices prohibited by law or seeking unfair advantage over fellow members and conform to all laws established by Municipal, State and Federal governments for the control of said business, where applicable.
10. Present a true presentation in all advertising. Goods and services shall be advertised in accordance with all Municipal, State and Federal legislation.
11. Respect the roles of the Chamber Executive, Committee Members and volunteers.
